This week, we will be researching information about Mexico to then plan and write a fact sheet about it. In order to find the correct information about Mexico you will need to use the skimming and scanning reading skills you practised last week!

I suggest you follow this order:

1. Think about what you already know about Mexico. Complete a 'KWL grid' about Mexico. K = know (what you already know about Mexico), W = want (what you want to know about Mexico) and L= learned (what you have learnt about Mexico- which you can complete as you learn different facts along the way, or at the end of the week).
2. Plan your fact sheet about Mexico by using the template, 'Country Snap Shot'. This will help guide your research. I have included 'Fact Cards' for you to read and add to your plan. This is especially useful for those who don't have good internet access.
3. Complete the, 'Day of the Dead', reading comprehension based on a Mexican celebration. Add information learnt here into your fact file plan.
4. Look at the 'Mexico Fact File' template to help direct your research further- add more information to your fact file plan and start to write your facts as a fact file.
5. Finish your fact file and reflect on what you have learnt about Mexico so far!

You could also learn about Mexico by looking at the 'Countries', pdf. There are lots of ideas on there. You might find something that you research particularly interesting, like, monarch butterfly migration. This might take your learning in a butterfly direction, which is absolutely fine- in fact it is encouraged : )
