Research the country's flag. Draw it. This could be on paper or on Paint on the computer.
You could re-design this country's flag using what you know about the country to aid your design.



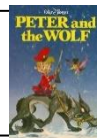
Research the country's traditional food and drink. You could make a menu using your research, draw examples of their food or try to bake some of their dishes.



Does this country have the same time as us? What is the time difference if it has one?
Do they have the same seasons as us?



Are there any stories based on this country that you know of?
You could research and try to read some.



What is the country's history? Has it been involved in any wars? Has the country had any key rulers?
Do they have any kings or queens?



Does this country have any native trees or plants? What type of food is grown in this country?



Does the country have any traditional music or musical instruments that the country is well known for?
You could try to make an instrument and/or try to play music in that style.



What is the climate of the country? Does it have different biomes across the country?
What is the climate like compared to the UK?



Does the country have traditional clothing?
You could draw some examples, make some for teddies/dolls or yourself.



What is the country's currency? DO any other countries use that currency?
You could research what their money looks like and make your own.



Research the country's language.
Try to learn key words and phrases. You could draw the word and label it in that language.

Does the country have any special events or days that they celebrate?
Have they held any special religious or sporting events?



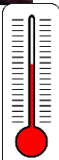
Locate the country on a map of the world. Find out its capital city. Does it have any key landforms like, volcanoes, mountains, big rivers and valleys? You could label them on the map.



Does the country have any well-known landmarks or buildings?
You could research these, draw them or try to create them!



What is the average rainfall and temperature of this country? You could draw graphs to show the data across the year. You could compare against England.



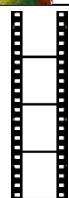
What is the current population?
What is their average height, their average age, their life expectancy? Etc



Does the country have any native or well-known animals?
Do these have particular adaptations, which helps them live in that country? You could draw or make a model to help show these adaptations.



Are there any films or kids programs based in this country?
You could watch it (with adult permission)
You could role-play your own film based in the country, make an animation, or draw a filmstrip.



Are there any famous artists or pieces of art from this country?
Can you draw or make something in the style of this art/artist?



What is the land mainly used for in this country? Is it mainly arable fields, pasture, managed woodland, urban/industrial purposes or something else?



What well-known football or other teams are there from this country?



You could try to draw their kit, create a new one for them or research their players and/or stadiums.
