<u>Maths</u>

For the small hall group, the learning focus is: times tables

Please make sure you are practising your times tables today; these will be very important next week. I have uploaded activity sheets of key times tables to focus on.

For year 5 the learning focus is: Multiply 2 numbers (area model)

English

For today's English work, follow the instructions on the PDF. You will be writing a passage of text using your learning from this week. Make sure you use a variety of compound and complex sentences in the writing task.

Spelling

Draw a picture, trying to include as many 'cious' and 'tious' words as you can. We have done this in class before. Either label your picture with the different spelling words you've used or put a word bank to one side to show which words you have included in the picture.

Example: you might draw a 'nutritious', 'delicious' meal that is being eaten by a not very 'cautious' lorry driver. Another driver noticed the lorry driver eating and was, 'ferocious' and 'vicious' towards them for eating and driving at the same time!

I've only included 5 words into my picture/scene. See if you can reflect back on the words you have been learning and include more than I have!

Reading

Please answer the uploaded questions based on a picture called, 'Red Hat'. This links with yesterday's PSHE focus of celebrating differences.

Computing

Today I would like you to try to send me some pictures of your work. If you have done this already, then you are ahead of the game. If the children could start to learn this process, it will benefit them in the future and might make things easier for parents too. If you have another arrangement of how I can see your work, then you also don't need to worry about the above, unless as a teaching point for the child.

Sending me photos of work, could be done in various ways. If you are running TEAMS on a tablet or phone, you could take photos of your different examples of work and then send them to me via the personal chat on TEAMS. There is a paper clip icon on the chat; this is how you 'attach' photos/work.

If you are running TEAMS on a laptop/computer, there will be more stages to send me photos of your work. You will probably find it easiest to send pictures via email. Either method would be great.
