Objectives covered in today's lesson

- *to know what pulse is
- *to recognise and find the pulse in a piece of music
- *to be able to clap the rhythm
- *to clap to the pulse whilst chanting at the same time
- *to use body percussion for rhythms
- *to listen with attention to detail and recall rhythms with increasing aural memory

You may need during this lesson

- *head phones (not necessary but might help to not distract others in your family)
- *pencil and paper
- *your hands and your bodies
- *you might want pens/pencils to tap the table with

During the video lesson, you can pause and rewind to try parts again. There are also challenges you might like to try on family members.
