English

Complete the uploaded work based on relative clauses. This builds on from yesterday's work. You will be learning how to drop a relative clause into a main clause (sentence).

By the end of the session hopefully you will feel confident writing sentences with relative clauses dropped in (embedded) into a sentence.

Spelling

Complete the uploaded spelling challenge. These are different for year 5, 6 and the small hall group.

*Small hall group will be focusing on words ending in 'ment' and 'ness'- sorting syllables into words.

*Y5 will be focusing on the suffixes 'cial' and 'tial'- matching definitions to the words and then writing your own sentences with the 'cial/tial' words in.

*Y6 will be focusing on the prefixes 'ir, il, im and in'- you will be completing a table to notice patterns in when to use which prefix.

Reading and R.E

Today you will be using your summarising skills to complete a reading activity based on the ancient Egyptian religious belief of their journey to the afterlife.

There are 2 uploads for this.

1)The first page of the first upload is an information page with information based on their religious belief; the second page is 'Ani's Journey to the Afterlife' which takes a closer look at one person's journey.

2) The second upload is for you to try to summarise 'Ani's Journey to the Afterlife'. There are 3 levels of difficulty for this. Pick the level best suited to you! The first page you need to draw pictures. The second page is a fill in the blank option and the third page (the page for most of you) is blank so you need to summarise in words and pictures!

History and PSHE

Today builds on your understanding of the ancient Egyptian belief about the afterlife. You learnt a little about the afterlife in the reading PowerPoint from the last two days and it links with today's reading challenge too.
