Spelling

Complete the uploaded spelling challenge. These are different for year 5, 6 and the small hall group.

*Small hall group will be focusing on words ending in 'ment' and 'ness' - you will be using a dictionary or online dictionary to investigate words

*Y5 will be focusing on the suffixes 'cial' and 'tial' - you will be playing a game to try to help you remember to choose 'cial' or 'tial' (remember the rule)

*Y6 will be focusing on the prefixes 'ir, il, im and in' - you will be playing a game to try to help you remember which prefix to use (think of the rules)

Reading and History

Today, we will again be building on our retrieval and summarising skills. You will read through the PowerPoint or PDF and find (retrieve) and summarise the key parts of the mummification process.

When we summarise, we only select the key parts- so do not spend ages writing. You could even draw pictures to summarise what you have read.
