## Maths:

### English:

Today, your task is to create your own hero and monster which you will use next week when you write your own myth. We have previously looked at the features of a myth and you will remember that the key features include: a hero, a monster, setting, journey, problem and resolution.

Thinking about the learning you have completed both this week and last week about description, your task is to create a character description of your hero and your monster. This will involve you thinking about what your myth might be about (we will plan and write this next week) and why your hero is heroic (do they slay the monster? Do they escape from the monster?). You will also need to think about your monster... will they be similar to the Minotaur? (See document 'English Task' in uploads)

I would like you to think about how we have innovated stories before in school. This will help you when planning your characters. See the stars to remind you of the challenge levels: \*Keep the myth the same as Theseus and the Minotaur and just change Theseus and the Minotaur to your own characters. \*\*Change the characters and setting. \*\*\*Change the whole myth ensuring the key features are still included: a hero, a monster, setting, journey, problem and resolution.

#### <u>Reading:</u>

Your task today is to answer some follow up questions about events in chapter 1 of Charlotte's Web. This will require your retrieval and explanation VIPERS skills initially to answer the questions based on what we have read so far. You will then need to make a prediction at the end. \*Remember that the text is uploaded on Wednesday's blog.

<u>Be active</u>: ARENA school games activity card- don't forget to send your points to Mrs Trevaskis. You could also complete an activity from the daily activity menu and get your heart rate up for 30 minutes. If you have any other suggestions for this menu, please let me know!
