
<u>French</u>

Pick one part of the sentence from each section of the table and write it in that order

(1, 2, 3 and then 4). Notice how the table is broken up- certain parts must stay with other certain parts. **Challenge:** Can you use '*et*' which means '*and*' in French.

Example: J'adore jourer au foot <u>et</u> j'aime faire du ski. (I love to play football <u>and</u> I like to ski)
